Sunday school focus: The key point of Sunday School today is that Jesus is our Passover Lamb, who with His very body and blood grants us forgiveness, life, and salvation. The children learn about the Last Supper, the Lord's Supper (Luke 22:1-23). In your family discussions, talk about the benefits and blessings that we receive in the Lord's Supper. Talk about and remind the children that such benefits are theirs through their Baptism, in Holy Absolution (the forgiveness of God spoken by the Pastor), and through God's Word, which is preached and taught to them. In the catechism, review the Lord's Supper.

Mission board: We once again have many of the children and youth of our congregation participating at the Yuma County Fair. Please come out and support them as they are judged on what is often almost a year's worth of effort. The afternoon on Wednesday, March 31, the Mission Board is encouraging people to gather at the 4H food booth, next to the show rings, for lunch and fellowship to help support our youth.
