**Pastor's Sunday Morning Bible Study:** Adventure on the high seas! Greed, lust, and scandal! Power politics! This may not sound like much of a Bible Study topic, but the next few weeks we will use the recently produced Walther movie which is about the first President of our Synod, C. F. W. Walther, and the founding of the LCMS. We will watch the movie and discuss the history surrounding it. Please join us.

**Wednesday Morning Bible Study:** In November we will restart our Wednesday Morning Bible Study. We are studying Genesis and we will meet at 11:00AM in the Sunday school building.
