Today’s Sunday school lesson is the account of God’s giving of the Ten Commandments to Moses (Exodus 19–20). The children will learn that “the law was given through Moses” but “grace and truth came through Jesus Christ” (John 1:17). Talk about God’s laws and how they guide us and show us our sin when we cannot keep them. Ask your children, “Who kept the Law perfectly for us?” Though we sin much, daily we have God’s forgiveness because of Christ, His Son. As a family, review the Ten Commandments.
