Pancake syrup: If anyone can make Clara Euhus's syrup recipe please let Janet know.

1.5 Quarts Syrup:

4Tbsp White Karo Syrup, 4Cups White Sugar, 3Cups Buttermilk, 3Tsp Soda, 1 Cube Butter, 1Tsp Vanilla.

Use large saucepan as it boils high. Turn heat on low put the Buttermilk in first then add the soda and let it bubble a bit, always stirring some. Add Butter, Karo, Sugar, vanilla, stir well. Let this come to a good rolling boil. Boil for 5 minutes. For thicker syrup boil a bit longer.
