

### MUSTARD SEED CALVARY LUTHERAN CHURCH February 2018

In just 2 short weeks, (February 14th) the season of Lent will be upon the Church as it begins the journey with Christ Jesus from the Mount of Transfiguration to Jerusalem where He will face the cross and the grave for the sake of saving mankind from sin. While Ash Wednesday falls on one of Hallmark's largest celebrated man-made holidays (i.e. Valentine's Day), the Church will take pause as it reflects on man's sinfulness and need for a Savior. The theme for our weekly Wednesday night meditations and for Holy Week is titled, "Return from Exile: A Lenten Journey."

As we begin our journey with Jesus, we will start with man's exile in the wilderness of sin and death as a result of Adam and Eve's first sin in the Garden of Eden. To be exiled means to be in a state of being barred for punitive reasons. Hence, when Adam and Eve ate of the forbidden fruit, they were barred from the Garden as punishment, having to labor for their sustenance and experience hardship and pain to bring forth offspring. No longer would they have direct access to the tree of life, and their relationship with God as they knew it was broken. Their sin and exile has been passed down from generation to generation, as we now wander in the wilderness of our sin and death, looking for the way out. But, like Adam and Eve, there is only one way out and it cannot be generated by man, but only by God, which is why our heavenly Father sent His only Son.

Every journey always has a destination, and our journey this Lent is no different. As we travel with Jesus, He takes our hand and leads us out from exile bringing us to the promised land...heaven itself, if you will...the ultimate destination Christ Jesus promises to us because of His selfless sacrifice and miraculous resurrection from the dead. This stirs tremendous joy within us as we are made to realize that in Christ we are no longer barred from heaven's paradise because our Father looks upon us in grace and declares us worthy of eternal life for Christ's sake.

Yet, as we journey with Jesus, there is also a somber attitude as we consider what Jesus faced because of our sin. Such love received a crown of thorns and stripes and ridicule. Such love received spikes of sin through His flesh. Such love received the darkness of death as He was laid in a tomb. Reflection on Jesus' Passion gives us the opportunity to contemplate the reality of our own earthly journey. However, we do not travel with Jesus blindly, but rather with our eyes fixed on our ultimate destination...namely the empty tomb and the open gates of heaven's promised land...a journey that we do not travel alone, but with our Savior by our side... a destination that truly is our reality as our Lord declares

us forgiven and restored to a right relationship with Him in Christ Jesus our Lord and our Savior.

Below, I have included the Wednesday evening Lent schedule and sermon topic. Under each date, I have included the Bible passage references for the sermon theme if you would like to read them prior to attending Also, Wednesday morning Bible midweek service. Class will have a sermon study for that evening's worship service, and all are invited to attend this class at 11:00 AM in the education building. encourage you to attend Lenten Midweek Services as this time together as God's forgiven children provides us with a moment to take pause from the busyness of our life's activities and responsibilities to humbly reflect and meditate on just how passionate our Lord is for us and what He was and is willing to do for us and for our salvation. Midweek worship services will Wednesday evenings at 7:00 PM with a potluck supper preceding the service at 6:00 PM. Won't you join me as together we journey with our Lord to His cross and empty tomb?




And remember: ALL women of the LCMS are considered LWML members. We hope to see you at these activities.

We have acquired a 2nd quote for repairs of the parking lots.







Currently the parking lot fund has a balance of \$19,463.00. The trustees have a lot to consider. As you can tell it is not <u>inexpensive</u> to repair the lots. For this reason we have not gone forth with the repairs as yet. We are still trying to raise enough money to do the job properly. We only have enough in the parking lot fund to fill the cracks and do a top seal which is not the ideal way to go.

If you would like to see what it would look like when finished with a 1" overlay, Brownie's Café parking lot was done this way. We would have to raise additional funds if this is the way we want to repair both lots.
